HIGH PERFORMANCE HANDGUN - *Both Provo and Baton Rouge*

Bank Miller - Action Target Academy

For better or for worse, the handgun remains the primary firearm for law enforcement work. This intensive program will help you develop techniques and tactics that are tactically efficient and effective for the handgun under stressful situations. Based on economy of motion, the unique techniques and tactics presented will elevate your operational efficiency far beyond that of basic skill development. You will be able to respond to hazardous situations rapidly and safely with determination and confidence. This will very likely be the most intense and action-packed firearms training class you will ever take.

This course is designed to instruct the law enforcement trainer how to conduct realistic and safe scenario training inside a live-fire shoothouse facility. Your training will take place in "MATCH", which is Action Target's Modular Armored Tactical Combat House. All aspects of shoot house safety will be addressed. The student will obtain insight into instructor responsibilities involved when conducting live fire training inside a shoot house. Students will also learn how the placement and location of target systems and instructors play a major role in overall safety. The student will leave with an understanding of angles of deflection, target placement and the implementation and importance of emergency action plans as they relate to effectively managing shoot house training.

DEVELOPING REFLEXIVE GUN HANDLING SKILLS - Both Provo and Baton Rouge

John Krupa - Team Spartan / Action Target Academy

This 8-hour training block focuses on developing combat mindset and aggressive gun-handling skills. The concepts of dominating the weapon, threat, and all visual areas while moving off the line of force will be emphasized throughout the class. Students will develop reflexive skills that will enable them to quickly and efficiently engage threats while performing multiple complex tasks. Students will be challenged and throughout the course with individual, team and man vs. man shoot-offs.

John is a police officer with the Chicago PD with over 14 years of experience in law enforcement. He is a certified firearms instructor with the Chicago PD, certified Master Firearms Instructor with the University of Illinois Police Training Institute, and a graduate firearms instructor from the Secret Service Academy, F.B.I., D.E.A. and Federal Law Enforcement Training Center.

SHOOT, MOVE, COMMUNICATE - Both Provo and Baton Rouge

Dennis Tueller – Glock Training Division

Tactical communication, controlled movement, use of cover, and accurate shooting - These are skills that must be effectively applied by armed personnel to resolve and survive close-range armed confrontations. Students will participate in range activities that will help them learn and apply techniques and tactics for integrating safe gun handling, marksmanship, mobility, and verbalization. Along with movement-oriented shooting exercises involving multiple stationary and moving targets, there is also a strong emphasis on the proper mind-set for combat survival.

As a retired 25-year veteran of the Salt Lake City PD, Dennis has trained thousands of men and women from throughout the world including law enforcement officers, police recruits, firearms instructors, federal agents, S.W.A.T. teams, military personnel, and corporate security specialists. Perhaps Dennis is best known for researching and developing ground breaking training protocol, as exemplified in his published seminal article, "How Close is Too Close." In that text, Dennis identified critical concepts ("proximics"), which influenced a revolution in tactical training doctrine (the "Tueller Principle").

THE ONE LIGHT SOLUTION - Provo only

Most officer involved shootings occur in low, altered, or failing light - and this course will prepare you for that moment. Using the latest in tactical flashlights, this course will cover the use of the First Light Liberator flashlight, your "one light," solution for tactical carbine and pistol. You will increase your marksmanship skill, decrease gun handling time, and decrease individual liability. When confronted with a lethal confrontation in low light, have the latest tool and training to win. Marksmanship, gun handling speed, and mental conditioning will be the focus around our training programs.

Troy Arce has more than 23 years of special operations experience. He is currently working protective details for high-level government officials. Troy is also an adjunct instructor and rangemaster at Gunsite Training Academy where he enjoys teaching classes to the special operations community and law enforcement.

DEFENSIVE TACTICS - Both Provo and Baton Rouge

Johnny Lee Smith & Jason Brook – SSGT Defensive Tactics / Action Target Academy

This 8-hour training block focuses on serious self-defense situations law enforcement officers face in the line of duty such as knife defense, in and out of holster handgun retention, and how to escape from various ground grappling attacks. These situations will be addressed with techniques that utilize gross motor skills so they will be available and effective under combat stress situations. Students will learn techniques that have actually been used by law enforcement officers in the line of duty.

Johnny is an Alabama POST certified specialized instructor for law enforcement. He is the founder and developer of the "Strategic Self-defense & Grappling Tactics" program, which is currently being taught to thousands of officers throughout the Southeastern United States. He started martial arts in 1979 and is a fifth degree Black Belt in Karate. He is also a second degree Black Belt in Brazilian Jujitsu under Carlos Machado, and has studied for many years under the legendary Rickson Gracie. Jason is currently the lead defensive tactics instructor for the Shreveport Police Academy in Louisiana. He served on Shreveport's SWAT team for nine years. He also serves on the SSGT Board of Directors.

SHOOTING ON REACTIVE STEEL FOR SPEED AND ACCURACY - Provo only

Peter Tarley – Police Training Division / Action Target Academy
